Political News from Ireland

Reuters News reports a "hard border" between Northern Ireland and the Irish Republic looks inevitable if Britain leaves the EU, says Ireland's EU Commissioner, farm chief Phil Hogan.

Northern Ireland will be the only land frontier Britain and the EU, once it leaves. Leaders in London, Dublin and Belfast said they want to avoid a hard border, with customs checks and border posts.

He added that he hoped the EU may be able to persuade London on a common position for the island of Ireland, to avoid such measures and preserve a common travel area between the two counties that predates their entry into the EU in 1972.
