Is This History?

Irish-The Forgotten White Slaves

Thanks to Brothers Jim Dunn and Jim Calpin for sending this <u>article</u> about James VI 's Proclamation of 1625 requiring Irish political prisoners sold to English settlers in the West Indies as slaves.

It sounds like a horrible story of abject murder, families ripped apart, homeless women an children and the drop in Irish population from 1.5 million to 600,000 in a decade. Being non-Catholic, African slaves were reportedly treated better than the Irish and interbreeding Irish females with African men was used to produce "mulatto" slaves until stopped in 1681 because it interfered with the profits of slave importing.

Is this true?


Being a little curious about the story, your editor Googled on "Irish Slave Trade" myth and came up with a vast list of references about this meme, a collection of half-truths, myths, self-serving blogs and opinions about Irish bondage. (To be exact, 2,380,000 results were returned by Google).

It is reported that there is no record of Irish chattel slavery in North America. It is also reported that there were a large number of Irish indentured servants forcibly shipped to the colonies, including a large majority that came here voluntarily.

Probably one of the better articles, <u>"Black Lives Matter and the 'Irish Slave Myth'"</u> gives a more global approach to the issue. The website stormfront.org, a white su-

premacist organization mentioned, propagates the <u>same information</u> found elsewhere on the web almost word-forword.

Can we come to any conclusions on Irish "slavery"? Probably not. There doesn't seem to be any scholarly infor-



mation immediately apparent but there's certainly a lot of self-serving blogs, sites and other trolling out there. I would also refer you to "White Cargo", a reference to the pro-existence of Irish slavery. It

might be a good place to start reading.
