Theresa May has been in contact with EU leaders over Christmas to try to seek the reassurances she hopes will persuade enough MPs to back her Brexit deal in January, Downing Street has said.

"She has been in contact with European counterparts over the break, and you can expect more of that to continue over the week," the prime minister's spokeswoman said.

"I haven't got a list for you, but she has been in touch with European leaders, and that will continue in the lead-up to the vote." Continued

# Fifty Years Ago

(1<sup>st</sup> Jan). An offshoot of the Civil Rights Movement, **People's Democracy (PD)**, marched for iobs, houses, rights for the Catholic minority and 'one man, one vote'. Their aim was to promote a socialist republic for all of Ireland. Founded by Bernadette Devlin. And nine other students at Queen's university, they were attacked by Protestants, including uniformed RUC in their march from Belfast and Derry. No attackers were arrested, but eighty marchers were. Then the police stirred trouble (including assault, damage of property) on Bogside. The same pattern was to continue throughout the year. PD was especially active around the issues of internment and prisoners' rights. Following the formation of the National H-Block/Armagh Committee in 1979 to build support for the Republican prisoners then on the "blanket protest" in support of political status and the subsequent death of Bobby Sands and nine of his comrades during the H-Block hunger strikes, a number of members of the organization, led by Vincent Doherty - then a member of the Political Committee and a former party general election candidate - argued that PD should ioin Sinn Féin, which had moved openly to the left in the late 1970s and early 1980s. In the early 1990s the remaining members of PD initiated the Irish Committee for a Marxist Programme as an attempt to regroup socialists and left wing republicans. This project ended in 1996, when PD dissolved and reconstituted itself as Socialist Democracy.


