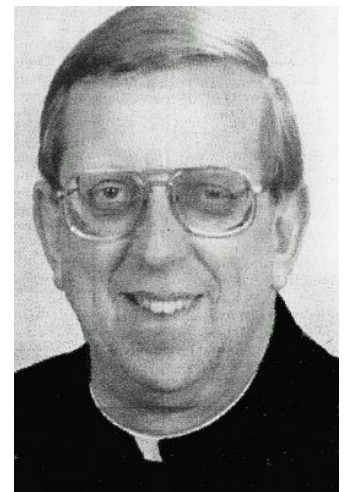
I look forward to seeing all of you on the 12th.
